The June 2017 average price received by farmers for **corn** in Wisconsin was \$3.42 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was up \$0.06 from May but down \$0.33 from the previous June.

The June **soybean** price, at \$9.19 per bushel, was down \$0.17 from May and down \$1.11 from the previous June.

The June **oat** price was \$2.97 per bushel, \$0.40 higher than the May price and \$1.31 above June 2016.

**All hay** prices in Wisconsin averaged \$107.00 per ton in June, unchanged from May but up \$17.00 from June 2016. The **alfalfa hay** price averaged \$113.00 per ton in June, down \$7.00 from May but up \$18.00 from the previous June. The **other hay** price averaged \$74.00, up \$8.00 from May and \$10.00 above the June 2016 price.

The June average price was \$17.90 per cwt for **milk**, up \$0.50 from May and \$3.00 above June a year ago. Prices for replacement milk cows averaged \$1,650 per head as of July 1, 2017.

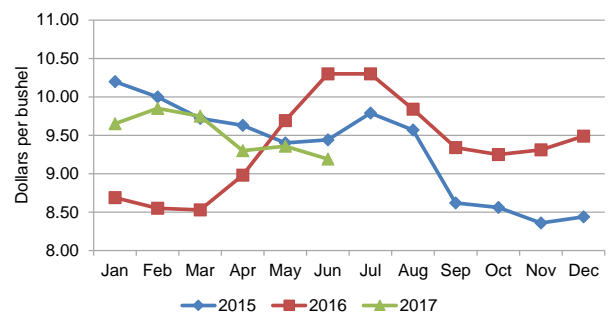
