The August 2017 average price received by farmers for **corn** in Wisconsin was \$3.32 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was down \$0.13 from July but up \$0.20 from the previous August.

The August **soybean** price, at \$9.34 per bushel, was down \$0.07 from July and down \$0.50 from the previous August.

The August **oat** price was \$2.34 per bushel, \$0.23 below the July price but \$0.87 above August 2016.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$92.00 per ton in August, down \$1.00 from July but up \$20.00 from August 2016. The **alfalfa hay** price averaged \$97.00 per ton in August, down \$6.00 from July but up \$18.00 from the previous August. The **other hay** price averaged \$79.00, up \$9.00 from July and \$33.00 above the August 2016 price.

The August average price was \$18.20 per cwt for **milk**, up \$1.10 from July and \$0.20 above August a year ago.

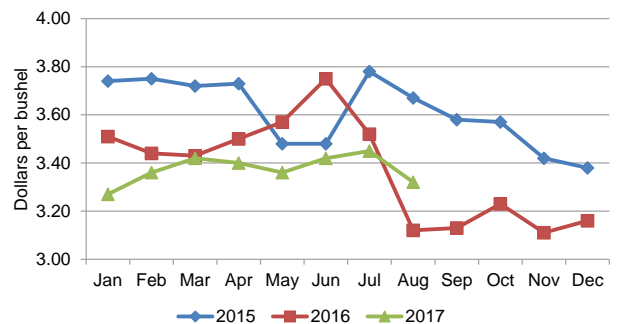
