## Wisconsin Ag News – Milk Prices

The Wisconsin all milk price for April 2018 was \$16.30 per hundredweight (cwt) according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was 10 cents higher than last month's price but 90 cents lower than last April's price.

The U.S. all milk price for April was \$15.80 per cwt, 50 cents lower than Wisconsin's price but 20 cents higher than last month's U.S. price. Twenty-one of the 23 major milk producing states had a higher price when compared with March. Idaho was the only state to have a lower price, down 20 cents to \$15.30 per cwt., while Texas had no change in its price from last month.

The Chicago Mercantile Exchange\* (CME) 40-pound block cheese price closed at \$1.6075 per pound on May 30, while barrels were \$1.5575 per pound. The CME butter price was \$2.4250 per pound.

For the week ending May 19, 2018, the Agricultural Marketing Service\* U.S. weekly 40-pound block cheese price averaged \$1.6785 per pound, and 500 pound barrels adjusted to 38 percent moisture averaged \$1.6147 per pound. The U.S. butter price was \$2.3243 per pound.
