The May 2018 average price received by farmers for **corn** in Wisconsin was \$3.64 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was up \$0.12 from April and \$0.29 above the previous May.

The May **soybean** price, at \$9.84 per bushel, was up \$0.07 from April and \$0.50 above the previous May.

The May **oat** price was \$3.20 per bushel, down \$0.04 from the April price but \$0.63 above May 2017.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$156.00 per ton in May, up \$2.00 from April and \$49.00 above May 2017. The **alfalfa hay** price averaged \$171.00 per ton in May, up \$6.00 from April and \$51.00 above the previous May. The **other hay** price averaged \$109.00 per ton in May, down \$11.00 from April but \$43.00 above the May 2017 price.

The May average price was \$16.70 per cwt for **milk**, up \$0.40 from April but \$0.70 below May a year ago.

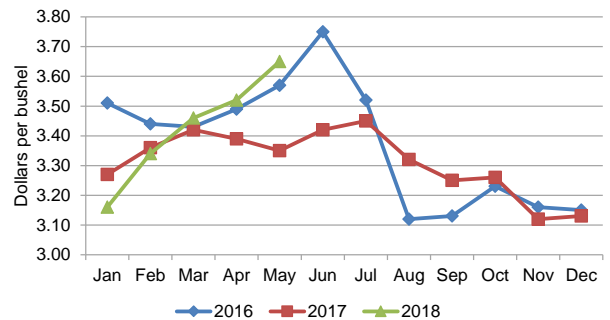
