The April 2018 average price received by farmers for **corn** in Wisconsin was \$3.52 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was up \$0.06 from March and \$0.13 above the previous April.

The April **soybean** price, at \$9.77 per bushel, was down \$0.03 from March but \$0.44 above the previous April.

The April **oat** price was \$3.24 per bushel, down \$0.07 from the March price but \$0.69 above April 2017.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$154.00 per ton in April, up \$30.00 from March and \$65.00 above April 2017. The **alfalfa hay** price averaged \$165.00 per ton in April, up \$30.00 from March and \$72.00 above the previous April. The **other hay** price averaged \$120.00 per ton in April, up \$30.00 from March and \$50.00 above the April 2017 price.

The April average price was \$16.30 per cwt for **milk**, up \$0.10 from March but \$0.90 below April a year ago.

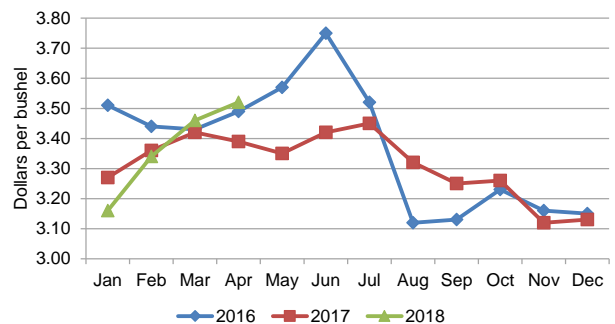
