The July 2018 average price received by farmers for **corn** in Wisconsin was \$3.43 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was down \$0.14 from June and \$0.02 below the previous July.

The July **soybean** price, at \$9.30 per bushel, was down \$0.54 from June and \$0.11 below the previous July.

The July **oat** price was \$2.61 per bushel, down \$0.67 from the June price but \$0.04 above July 2017.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$117.00 per ton in July, down \$27.00 from June but \$26.00 above July 2017. The **alfalfa hay** price averaged \$127.00 per ton in July, down \$21.00 from June but \$24.00 above the previous July. The **other hay** price averaged \$94.00 per ton in July, down \$24.00 from June but \$24.00 above the July 2017 price.

The July average price was \$15.30 per cwt for **milk**, down \$1.20 from June and \$1.80 below July a year ago.

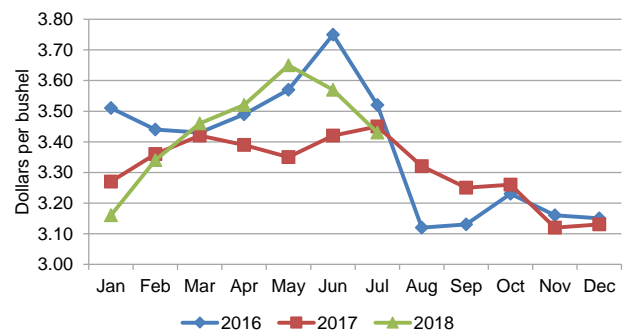
