The August 2018 average price received by farmers for **corn** in Wisconsin was \$3.35 per bushel according to the latest USDA, National Agricultural Statistics Service – *Agricultural Prices* report. This was down \$0.08 from July but \$0.03 above the previous August.

The August **soybean** price, at \$8.70 per bushel, was down \$0.60 from July and \$0.64 below the previous August.

The August **oat** price was \$2.60 per bushel, down \$0.01 from the July price but \$0.26 above August 2017.

All hay prices in Wisconsin averaged \$122.00 per ton in August, up \$5.00 from July and \$30.00 above August 2017. The **alfalfa hay** price averaged \$134.00 per ton in August, up \$7.00 from July and \$37.00 above the previous August. The **other hay** price averaged \$91.00 per ton in August, down \$3.00 from July but \$12.00 above the August 2017 price.

The August average price was \$16.20 per cwt for **milk**, up \$0.90 from July but \$2.00 below August a year ago.

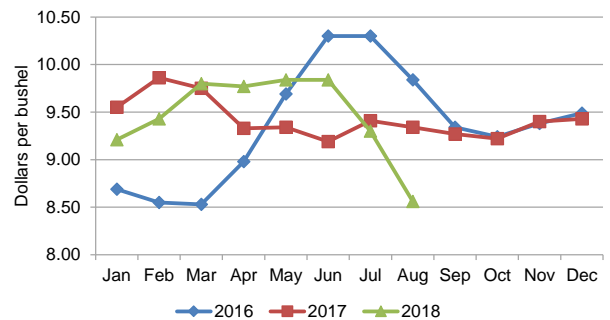
